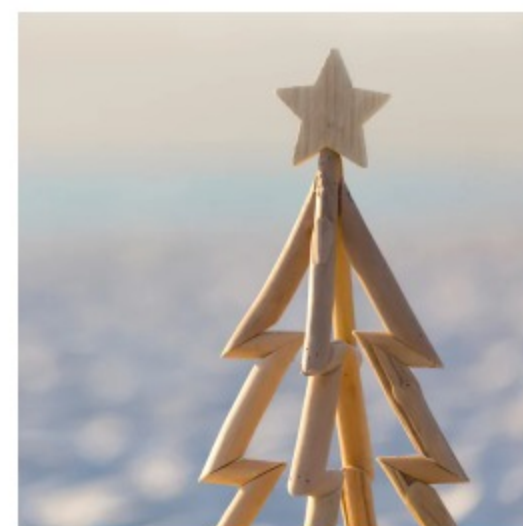


Digital Project: website consolidation
